GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Le Club AccorHotels General Conditions of Use and Le Club AccorHotels Meeting Planner General Terms and apply to this Offer and the terms and conditions herein.

“Eligible Event” means any meeting, conference or other professional event booked and held at the hotels participating in this Offer, and in accordance with the Le Club AccorHotels Meeting Planner General Terms & Conditions.

“Offer” means the award of Le Club AccorHotels bonus Rewards points.

OFFER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- To qualify to receive the Offer, the following criteria must be met:
 - Offer is only open to Le Club AccorHotels Meeting Planner members (as defined under the Meeting Planner Terms and Conditions at www.accorhotels.com/meetingplanner). To join the program, visit www.meetingplanner-accorhotels.com/greatthings.
 - the Offer is only valid for Eligible Events with a total minimum spend of AU\$5,000 which are booked between 16 July 2018 and 30 November 2018, both dates inclusive (“Campaign Duration”), in any of the participating hotels in Australia, New Zealand, Fiji and French Polynesia (for a list of non-participating hotels go to https://www.accorhotels.com/gb/leclub/user/hotels_exception.shtml), and held between 1 August 2018 and 31 December 2019 (both dates inclusive).
 - the Eligible Events must be contracted and deposit paid for before the member can receive the bonus Le Club AccorHotels Rewards points;
 - the Le Club AccorHotels Loyalty card number must be included in the event contract.
- The number of Eligible Events eligible for the Offer is unlimited.
- The Offer is awarded in Le Club AccorHotels Rewards points, not Le Club AccorHotels Status points. 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PRIZE COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Section 1: Promotion

1. **Promotion:** Contract an event at any participating AccorHotels property in Australia, New Zealand, Fiji or French Polynesia between 16 July 2018 and 30 November 2018, for events to be held between 1 August 2018 and 31 December 2019, and go in the draw to win either a holiday to London (for event spends of AU\$25,000 or more), or Bora Bora (for event spends between AU\$5,000 and AU\$24,999).

2. **The Promoter** is AAPC Limited (ABN 87 009 175 820) of Level 30, Angel Place, 123 Pitt Street, Sydney, NSW, 2000, Australia.
3. **Promotion period:** The promotion will commence at 12.01am (AEST) on 16 July 2018 and will close at 11.59pm (AEDT) on 30 November 2018. All times recorded throughout these terms and conditions are in Australian Eastern Standard Time and Australian Eastern Daylight Time.

Section 2: Eligibility

4. **Eligibility:** To be eligible to participate in this Promotion, the participant must during the Promotion:
 - a) be above 18 years of age; and
 - b) be a current member of the Le Club AccorHotels Meeting Planner Loyalty Program for the duration of the Promotion; and
 - c) be a resident of Australia, New Zealand, Fiji or French Polynesia, and;
 - d) have signed a hotel event contract (valid for new bookings only), and paid the non-refundable deposit, with a participating hotel between 16 July 2018 and 30 November 2018, for an event to be held between 1 August 2018 and 31 December 2019
 - e) have signed a hotel event contract with a minimum spend of AU\$25,000 (or NZ\$25,000, or the equivalent participating country's currency value) to enter Draw 1 to win a trip to London, or spend AU\$5,000 - AU\$24,999 (or NZ\$5,000 - AU\$24,999, or the equivalent participating country's currency value) to enter Draw 2 for a trip to Bora Bora;
 - f) adhere to the edibility rules of the Le Club AccorHotels Meeting Planner program (terms and conditions can be found at www.accorhotels.com/meetingplanner)

Section 3: Entry to the Promotion

5. To enter the Promotion, eligible entrants must:
 - a) Sign a hotel event contract and pay a non-refundable deposit with a participating hotel during the Promotion period to automatically receive one (1) entry into the applicable prize draw for every event contracted during the Promotion period.

Section 4: Draws

6. **Draws:** A representative of the Promoter will conduct two computerised random draws from all eligible entries at 2.00pm (AEST/AEDT) at MDSA, Level 2, 40 Yeo Street, Neutral Bay NSW 2089 on 7 December 2018. All eligible entrants who spend AU\$25,000 or more will be entered in Draw 1 for the London Prize, and all eligible entrants who spend AU\$5,000 - AU\$24,999 will be entered in Draw 2 for the Bora Bora Prize.

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Section 5: Prizes

7. Prize Components & Conditions:

There are two prize draws and one (1) prize to be won in each draw. The first eligible entrant in each draw will receive the applicable prize. The 2 prizes are;

- a) **Draw 1 Prize:** A trip to London – Seven (7) night's in a Deluxe King room including breakfast for two people at The Savoy in London with business class flights for two from the winner's capital city. Maximum Draw 1 prize value is AU\$18,000.

 - b) **Bora Bora Prize** - Prize must be taken between 15 January 2019 and 31 May 2020 and is subject to availability of flights and accommodation. Black-out periods apply between 1 June and 30 October 2020.
 - c) **Transport** - Prizes do not include transport or any transfers to/from each hotel.

9. If a prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or greater value, subject to state regulation and subsequent approval.

Section 6: Prize Winner

10. **Contact:** The Promoter will contact the Prize Winners in writing within two (2) business days of each draw to confirm their eligibility under these terms and conditions and to confirm whether the Prize Winner wishes to claim their Prize. The names of the two Prize Winners will also be published in The Australian newspaper on 14 December 2018.
11. **Claim of Prize:** If a Prize Winner wishes to claim their Prize, the Prize Winner must confirm this fact and their eligibility to win under these terms and conditions within 3 months of the applicable draw. If a Prize Winner fails to do so by the deadline, the Prize Winner will be deemed to have forfeited their Prize.

The Promoter, its related bodies corporate, their officers, employees and agents will not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury whatsoever (including but not limited to direct, indirect, consequential and economic loss) suffered or sustained in connection with this Promotion, the promotion of this Promotion, or the use of any Prizes, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
